## Scout-O-Rama Set For October

WESTFIELD - Boy Scouts and Cub Scouts of the Colonial District of Westfield, Scotch Plains, Fanwood, Mountainside, and Garwood, are busy selling tickets to the Watchung Area Council Scout-O-Rama to be held October 16-18, at Somerset County Park, Somerville, according to plans outlined Wednesday evening at the district's first roundtable meeting of the new scouting season at Westfield High School.

Characterized as "The Handbooks of Scouting Come Alive," the Scout-O-Rama is a dramatic presentation of the advancement program of the Boy Scouts depicted in exhibits and demonstrations prepared and managed by the boys and their leaders. It is an opportunity for the public to see the latest in scouting activities and other ways in which scout units foster boys interests. For example, Troop 203 of Scotch Plains plans to set up and operate a ham radio station at which any licensed operator is invited to communicate. The station expects to make contact with a station in Switzerland during the exhibition.

Public purchase of the Scout-O-Rama tickets at \$1.00 each provides a means of income for the unit from which purchased, as sales are made on a commission basis. In some cases these tickets sales may be the units' only fund raising activity for the year. The park is located in Somerville off Route 202. Milltown Road is the first right turn after the R.C.A. plant on Route 202.

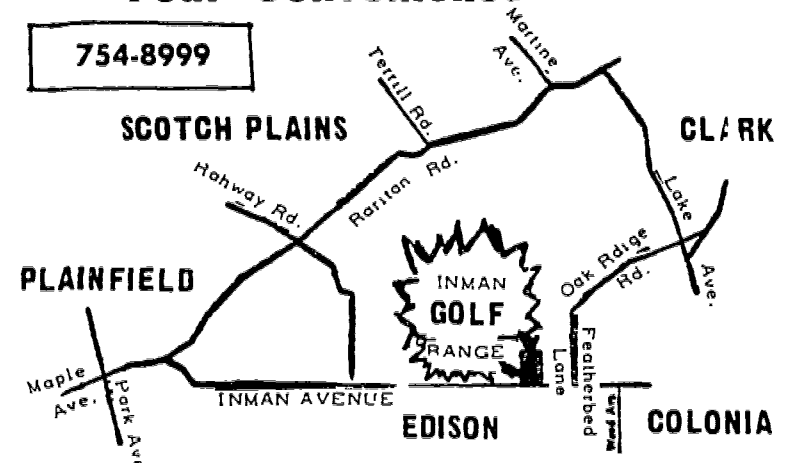

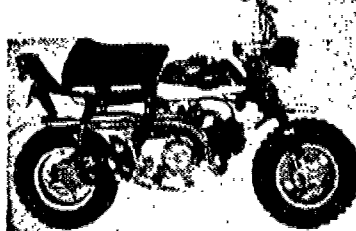
