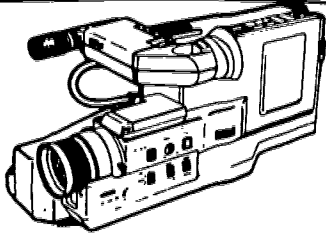
BOARD TO HEAR PRESENTATION ON GUIDANCE PROGRAM

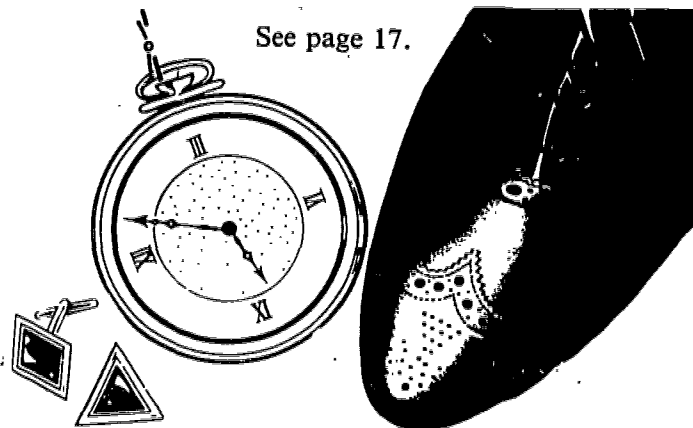
